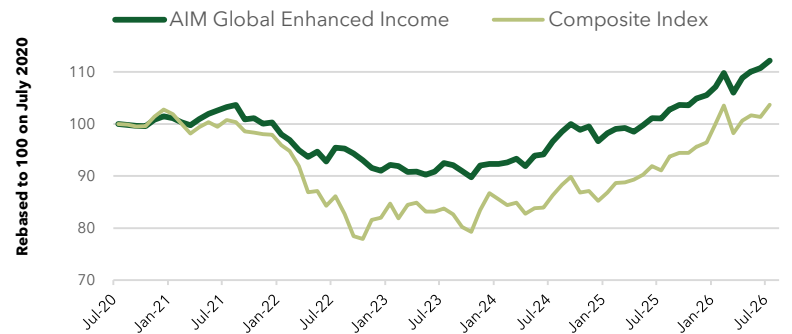
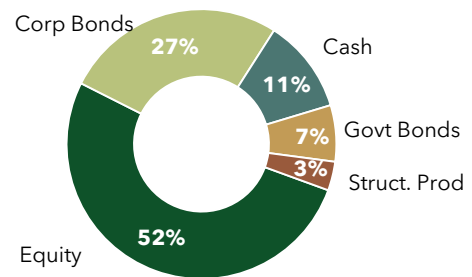
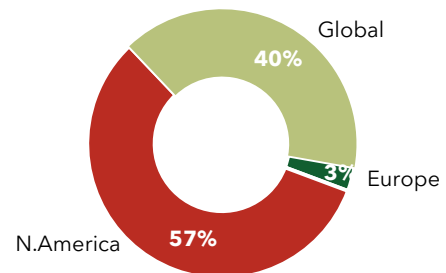

COMMENTARY

The fund and the benchmark gained **1.3%** and **2.3%**, respectively over the month.

Equities were the main contributor to performance during the month, despite volatility from renewed scrutiny around Artificial Intelligence (AI)-related valuations and capital spending. Sentiment was supported by resilient corporate earnings, while lower oil prices following progress in U.S.-Iran negotiations helped ease inflation concerns.

Fixed income delivered more modest returns, as yields remained sensitive to inflation expectations and shifting views on monetary policy.
